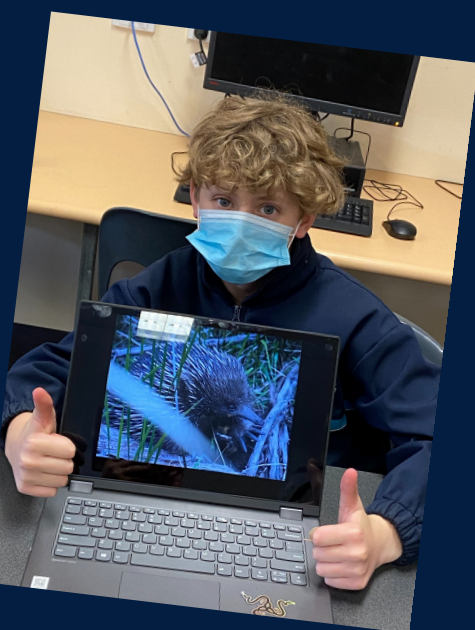
OVERALL 2020 WINNERS

7A students started their Personal Best Projects during remote learning, and some were able to finish them off in Term Four.



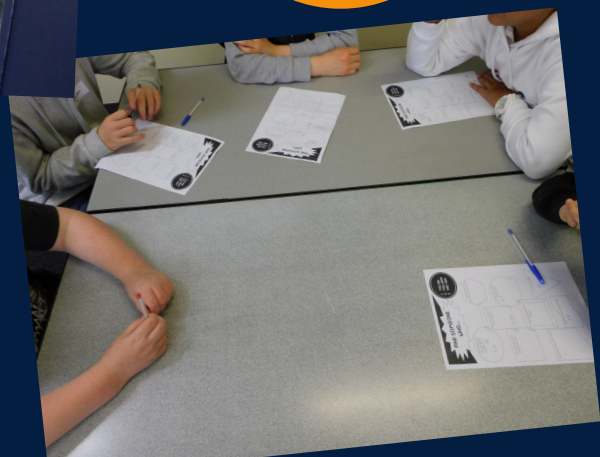

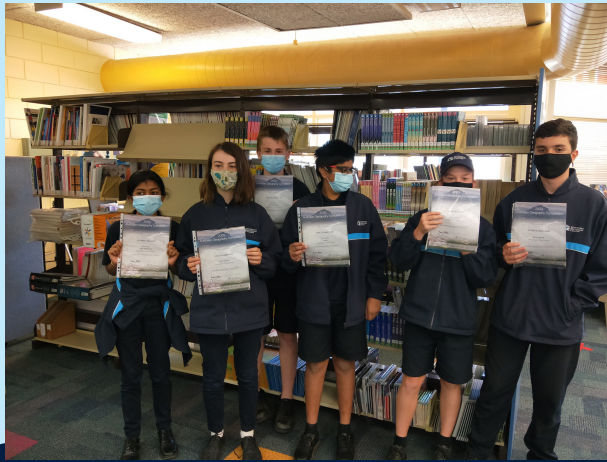
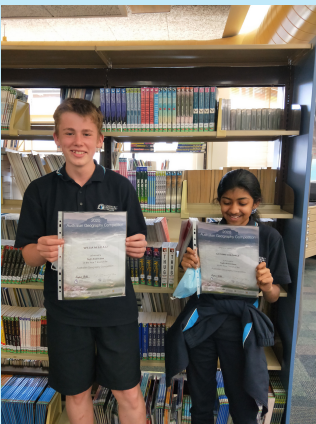


2021 Year 7 Student Orientation Day
