Dear Parents/Carers,

It is with great delight that we welcome the news from the Premier today that we can return to onsite learning tomorrow after three days of learning from home. We look forward to welcoming all our students back on site from Thursday 18th February.

Masks must be worn when inside and worn outside if you cannot socially distance. Please note that all students must bring a mask to school. The school only has a small number of masks for emergency use available.

I am so proud of our whole school community who rallied together last Friday to ensure students were able to access Compass, had devices and were ready for the three days of learning from home. It is timely to remind all our students to make sure that you take home any essential work and devices every so that we are always prepared for any eventuality.

May I also remind you that **if your child is ill or feeling unwell, they must not attend school**. You must keep them at home and away from others and seek medical guidance before returning to school. We ask all parents/carers to communicate with their child/ren how important it is to inform your parent/s or guardian or teacher, if you are feeling unwell. Please note that if a student or staff member presents as unwell during the school day, they will be escorted to First Aid immediately for assessment. Contactless thermometers will be available on site and temperatures will be checked should students present to First Aid. Should the student or staff member display any signs/symptoms associated with Covid-19, they will be required to be collected by a parent/guardian (student) or leave the campus immediately (staff member).

Social distancing will be adhered to for all adults on site. Can we please for this week ask that no parent/carer to come on site without a prior appointment which will help keep our community safe. Please adhere to all signage in relation to social distancing when on site.

A reminder that if year levels are present onsite, the provision of learning will be onsite. There will be no combination of remote learning and onsite learning for students. Exception to this rule may include students who are immunocompromised or with circumstances beyond their control that are preventing them from attending school. If your child is in this category, please contact your child's sub school leader to discuss the situation. The leadership at the college will review each case and identify the best appropriate supports.

We will continue to encourage physical distancing for students. Students will be expected to avoid gathering together in close proximity and reminders about this will be communicated to our students prior to attending on site. Staff will always remain vigilant in encouraging physical distancing.

I once again want to thank our whole school community for working together in these challenging times and we look forward to seeing all our students tomorrow.
